Motion

Be it moved and seconded that:

- **Because Cyren Call Communications has filed a proposal with the Federal Communications Commission that, if implemented, would be a great benefit to IAFC members and the fire service,**
- **Because Cyren Call Communications proposal appears to be inconsistent with Congressionally mandated spectrum auctions,**
- **Because proposals other than Cyren Call are expected to be introduced in the near future,**
- **Because all proposals dealing with any nationwide, broadband system that would benefit public safety are very complex requiring detailed analysis, and,**
- **Because nothing should stand in the way of implementing the 24 MHz of spectrum for public safety currently allocated,**

The Board directs staff to closely monitor, work with other executive public safety national organizations and be engaged with communications proposals that would benefit the fire service and public safety and to report to the Board at its next meeting on the progress of same.
